### Off and "Running"!

NJ candidates file their petitions to get on the ballot



On March 25th, all New Jersey candidates for June 4th's primary and November 5th's general election had to have petitions filed with Divisions of Elections throughout the state in order to get their names on the ballot That includes Mikie Sherrill and Bill Pascrell (left), Wayne's Representatives in Congress running for re-election. For weeks, all candidates have been gathering signatures for their petitions leading up to the filing date, and now the primary races are set. Both of our House incumbents are being challenged - Representative Sherrill by Mark De Lotto, and Representative Pascrell by Mohamed Khairullh. For Senate, Andy Kim, Lawrence Hamm and Patricia Campos-Medina are our three candidates after Tammy Murphy dropped out of the race. In Passaic County, there are also contested elections for three Commisioner seats, and for Sheriff after the untimely passing of Sheriff Berdnik.

Our volunteers gathered over 350 signatures for Mikie & Bill



Democracy is not a spectator sport" and some of our members are already "in the game". As every year, the Sherrill and Pascrell campaigns came to us to help them get their supporters to sign their petitions. Maybe you signed when we stopped by your house! Well, after several weeks of going door-to-door, we managed to get over 350 signatures which were part of our Representatives filings. Mikie Sherrill filed her petition with 3,706 signatures in her Congressional District II (CDII) while Bill Pascrell's total in CD9 was 2,535. Also, Democratic Senate candidate, Andy Kim, managed an impressive 6,345 signatures. (Note: Results are as of March 26th as reported by NJ Globe.)

### Fighting misinformation in a Republican town





No doubt being a Democrat in Wayne can be challenging. But burying our heads in the sand is a recipe for disaster, particularly this year with so much at stake. In late March, these signs (see pictures) started popping up around Wayne. The one on the far left, "See 2,000 Mules", refers to a documentary that pushes a long debunked right-wing conspiracy theory that there was coordinated voter fraud in the 2020 Presidential election. The second sign, "Remember Laken Riley", refers to the murder of a female University of Georgia student on campus by an undocumented migrant. While true, it's an incident that the right-wing is using politically to promote the false narrative that violent crime is rising dramatically (it's not), and it's all because of the influx of immigrants at our borders.

While we all will have our ideological differences, it's up to all of us to call out the lies and misinformation that we constantly see. These signs are troublesome, not only because they target an already-receptive audience, but because they are also directed at the most vulnerable among us - our kids. It seems that it's no coincidence that one sign was posted near Wayne Valley High School.

NOTE: These signs were posted on Verizon telephone poles on Hamburg Turnpike and Valley Road.

We've contacted Verizon and arranged for their removal.

If you come across any others, please do the same. You'll need to give Verizon the pole's location and it's number, located on the pole.
