Why you should VOTE BY MAIL

Was there ever a more important year for Democrats to have a great turnout at the polls? The answer to that is obvious, and getting you to Vote By Mail, if you aren't already, is a good way to make that happen. That said, here are some other advantages to voting by mail for you to consider.


- 1. All registered voters who apply to Vote By Mail get 45 days to vote. So there's no need to juggle time off work or get in line on Election Day.
- 2. Vote By Mail is done with PAPER ballots. It is convenient and low-cost: just a stamp for the enclosed Application.
- 3. Paper ballots are the MOST SECURE way to vote, all paper ballots go through an extensive validation process before they are counted on Election Day.

So, if you don't already vote by mail, get your "Application For Vote By Mail Ballot" (above), fill it out and send it in. You'll be voting in no time and, more importantly, you'll be helping to get our candidates elected!



Mikie Sherrill Secures Nearly \$1 Million in Federal Funding for Wayne

Congresswoman delivers aid to modernize Mountain View pumping station

Ask any Wayne resident what their main concern is in the community and chances are flooding is way up on the list. So too is the protection of our pristine lakes and waterways and our drinking water. Congresswoman Mikie Sherrill has been working alongside elected officials to advocate for this much-needed funding to modernize the outdated Mountain View pumping station, and their efforts recently came to fruition. The Congresswoman was on hand to present Wayne Mayor Chris Vergano with a check for \$959,752 to help pay for improvements to the pumping station which pumps sewage from approximately 30% of our township's properties. It was a win-win for all parties, but especially for the residents of Wayne!
